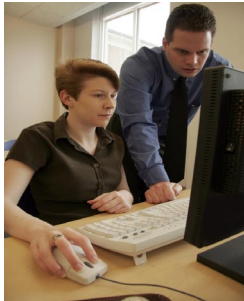


Internship Program

Our Internship Program is designed specifically for advanced level students and professionals who want to practice and improve their English skills in an American Business work environment.

This is an unpaid language and work experience for students who attend an 8-week language course first and complete at least the High Intermediate level.



This course is not a job training program and is not intended to lead to employment opportunities. Participants must have prior experience or training in the field of the internship.

Participants meet with the Internship Coordinator during the 8-week language course before the internship to develop their resume, review business vocabulary and learn interview skills. Each candidate is then placed in an internship based on prior work experience and language proficiency.

Professional Internship fields can include:

- Advertising
- Architecture
- Sales/Marketing
- Legal Services
- Business Administration
- Banking/Financial Services
- Information Technology
- Hospitality & Tourism

During the Internship, students meet every week with the Internship Coordinator to discuss their progress. They also work on special assignments, attend workshops and complete an individualized self-study plan (5 hours per week) in the school. Progress and attendance are carefully monitored by the Internship Coordinator.



An Internship Certificate and a Progress Report are issued to all participants who successfully complete the program. Placement in a specific field is based on availability and cannot be guaranteed.

- minimum 8-week English course at Brandon College
- complete at least High Intermediate level
- minimum age: 18 years or older
- length of internship: 8 or 12 weeks
- develop professional resume & interview skills prior to internship
- 30-35 hours internship + 5 hours instruction, lab and assignments
